## European Data Protection Day

The European Data Protection Day is celebrated each year on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January by the Member States of the Council of Europe.

In 2020 we celebrate 39 years since the adoption in Strasbourg, on the 28th of January 1981, of Convention no. 108 for the protection of individuals with regard to automatic processing of personal data – the first European legal instrument in the data protection field.

The rights established by Regulation(EU)2016/679, applicable starting with the  $25^{th}$  of May 2018:

- *right to information;*
- right of access;
- *right to object;*
- *right of intervention;*
- right not to be subject to an individual decision;
- right to be forgotten;
- right to restriction of processing;
- right to data portability.
- right to submit a complaint to the national supervisory authority;
- right to refer to a court of law.





Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC sets out the general rules on the processing of personal data, the rights of individuals and the obligations of data controllers throughout the European Union.
