European Data Protection Day

The European Data Protection Day is celebrated each year on the 28th of January by the Member States of the Council of Europe.

In 2019 we celebrate 38 years since the adoption in Strasbourg, on the 28th of January 1981, of Convention no. 108 for the protection of individuals with regard to automatic processing of personal data – the first European legal instrument in the data protection field.







Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC sets out the general rules on the processing of personal data, the rights of individuals and the obligations of data controllers throughout the European Union.
