Videoconference at the General Inspectorate of Romanian Police

On 4th and 5th of September 2007, the first level of professional training of General Inspectorate of Romanian Police (GIRP) took place, with the participation of the county inspectorate from the whole country, program which part of the one initiated by the national supervisory authority and established together with GIRP.

This training was accomplished through videoconference and consisted in the presentation of Law no. 677/2001, of the legislation in the Schengen domain and of the notification form. The presentation was sustained from Bucharest, by Mrs. Nicoleta Rusu.

The opening of the training sessions was done by Mrs. Georgeta Basarabescu – the president of the supervisory authority, from the premises of GIRP.

The presentation was followed by debated concerning the framework and conditions for disclosing the data and the necessity for realizing, as soon as possible, at the boards of each police unit, the information regarding the rights of the citizens provided by Law no. 677/2001 and by the legislation referring to the accession to the Convention implementing the Schengen agreement.

On 5th of September 2007, the intervention of the president of the supervisory authority took place at the premises of Bistrița county Police

Inspectorate, occasion with which the necessity for ensuring the security of the database and the existence at the level of each inspectorate of a person responsible with the protection of personal data was stressed out. In the final phase of the discussions, it was pointed out the fact that the image and the registration number of vehicles are personal data and, in the situation of processing these data through video surveillance systems, it is subject to notification to the supervisory authority, by reporting the purpose for which these data are being used.

The session was closed by Mrs. Georgeta Basarabescu and by Mr. Gheorghe Iancu – the deputy of the general inspector from GIRP, who underlined the utility of this training at the level of police and the continuation of this step to the next level of management.
